Raritan's TMCAT17 1U LCD KVM switch enables the setup, administration and maintenance of rack-mounted servers in data centers and other space-critical environments. It offers the convenience of using standard UTP cabling to connect to servers directly, while an optional second user is able to access servers up to 650 feet away. TMCAT17 is compatible with Windows®, Linux®, Mac® and Sun™ servers.

Two models are available, each in a 1U rack-mount form factor: TMCAT1728, which enables two users control of up to 8 servers simultaneously, and TMCAT17216, which allows two users control of up to 16 servers simultaneously.
